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What is the REACT project?

The REACT project aims at the creation of a European Energy Efficiency in Buildings Technician Qualification (EEEBT), EQF level 4 and have the propose:

- Create the REACT Curriculum, including a Competence Matrix (using Learning Outcomes (LOs) adequate to the specific EQF level).
- Compile the REACT summative assessment framework.
- Build a virtual serious game to be played throughout the CUs as formative assessment.
- Develop digital training materials of multiple formats
- Design the REACT RPL (Recognition of Prior Learning) scheme and tools.
- Set up a guideline for further exploitation of the qualification.

Workshop main goals

REACT EU transfer workshop is designed to:

- Provide trainers with the opportunity to learn about the REACT curriculum
- Get familiar with the digital training materials
- Get to know the assessment framework
- Participants will have the opportunity of participating in the pilot's phase, making the adaptation process to national context much more feasible, effective and sustainable at the long term.
